

RESIDENT ACTIVITY CARD REQUIREMENTS

Only City of Commerce residents may obtain a Resident Activity Card. Residency is defined as: living in a residential unit, such as a house, apartment, or condominium. Hotels are not included. Resident is defined as: Residents who reside full time in residential units mentioned above, that are in the City of Commerce. Part-time residency is not eligible for resident cards except for minors or adult children attending college.

REGISTRATION FOR RESIDENT ACTIVITY CARD:

Residents must register at the City of Commerce Brenda Villa Aquatic Center to obtain a Resident Activity Card. When applying for a card, residents will need to bring a current California Driver License or California I.D. and documents proving residency in the City of Commerce.

ADULTS:

Any person 18 years and older is considered an adult and must bring the following in his/her name:
Current California Driver License or California I.D. with their current Commerce address.
A current utility bill (electronic bills with a PDF copy of statement are acceptable). If a resident does not have a utility bill in his/her name, three (3) forms of monthly billings with a corresponding Commerce address may be used.
Acceptable monthly bills include: Wireless, internet provider, pay check stub, credit card statement, automobile payment, car insurance, vehicle registration documentation, Medi-Cal, Social Security, TANF, child support documentation, delinquent collection notices, college registration, student loans.

CHILDREN:

A Resident Activity Card will be issued to children with an original birth certificate when the parent has met the Resident Activity Requirements for an adult.

ADULT - AGES 18-27 YEARS OLD LIVING WITH PARENTS:

Adults must provide a current California Driver License or California I.D. and parent's current utility bill, or three (3) forms of documentation along with the parent's current resident card, California Drive License or California I.D.

SENIOR CITIZENS:

A Permanent Resident Activity Card will be issued to seniors 70 years and older who meet the adult resident requirements. Every 5 years residency needs to be reverified.

NON-RESIDENT GRANCHILD OF COMMERCE RESIDENTS:

A Grandchild Resident Activity Card will be issued to a child whose grandparents meet the Resident Activity Card Requirements for an adult and have shown reasonable proof of parentage to obtain this card. The original birth certificate is required to verify age and lineage. Copies will not be accepted. Grandchild residency eligibility expires on their 19th birthday.

INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITY CARD:

Industrial Residents may purchase an Industrial Activity Card for an annual fee of \$300.00. This fee will be prorated based on the month one joins. A current California Driver License or California I.D. along with a current paystub must be provided to obtain membership. The industrial cardholder is entitled to use the facilities at the Brenda Villa Aquatic Center and all fitness classes.

FEES: | **Basic Resident Activity Card: \$7.00**
Allows residents to sign up for any resident programs at resident rate.

FEES: | **Plus Resident Activity Card for 16 years-59 years: Basic Fee + \$99.00= \$106.00**
Allows residents access to Fitness Center, Water Aerobics, Lap Swim and all fitness classes.
